It comprised an Orbiter, Lander and Rover to explore the unexplored South Pole of the Moon. ... On August 20, 2019, **Chandrayaan-2** was successfully inserted into lunar orbit.

Chandrayaan-2 is the second lunar exploration mission developed by the Indian Space Research Organization, after Chandrayaan-1.

On 21st Sept, 2019, the students of std III & IV made the project on Chandrayaan-2 by making charts, drawing, models and also the information about the same.

“No to Polybag” Activity

Chandrayan 2

Chandrayan 2 is an Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) mission comprising an orbiter and a soft-lander carrying a rover, scheduled to launch in the fall of 2022.

The primary objective of Chandrayan 2 is to demonstrate the ability to soft-land on the lunar surface and operate a rover over the surface.

Key features include:

- Orbiter: Will orbit the Moon and provide continuous communication between the lander, rover, and ISRO.
- Propulsion Module: Will carry the lander and rover to the Moon.
- Landings Module: Will carry the rover and land on the Moon.
- Rover: Will explore the lunar surface and collect samples.
